Tasting notes	Nice and bright ruby robe. Complex nose with notes of fresh fruit, plum, cherry and well-matured torrefacted notes. The palate is balanced with mellow tannins bringing roundness to this wine. The finish displays notes of strawberry, blackberry and blueberry marmalades.
