

CHATEAU CROIX DE BERTINAT SAINT-EMILION GRAND CRU 2019

PRESENTATION OF THE CHATEAU CROIX DE BERTINAT

Located in the town of Saint Sulpice de Faleyrens, 3 km southwest of Saint-Emilion, Château Croix de Bertinat covers an area of 8.3 hectares in AOC Saint-Emilion and 0.3 hectares in AOC Bordeaux. The entire vineyard benefits from a sandy and gravelly soil conducive to the production of high quality wines.

THE VINEYARD

SURFACE: 8.3 hectares

GRAPE VARIETIES: 60% Merlot; 35% Cabernet Franc; 5% Cabernet Sauvignon

AVERAGE AGE OF THE VINES: 35 years

HARVEST: manual, manual sorting at the winery

VINIFICATION

VATS: stainless steel, thermo-regulated

VATTING: 24 days

AGEING: 12 month in french oak barrels (67% of new barrels)

PRODUCTION in 2019: 14 000 bottles

WINE DESCRIPTION

This round and fruity wine is made from a blend of Merlot (50%), Cabernet Franc (25%) and Cabernet Sauvignon (25%) and comes from vines aged 35 years on average, planted in terroir of gravel and clay sands on gravel.

Its traditional vinification and aging in oak barrels give it the finesse and elegance of a great Saint-Emilion wine. This wine will captivate you with its aromas of black fruits and spices, its delicate tannins and its harmonious woodiness.

Château Croix de Bertinat AOC Saint-Emilion Grand Cru 2019 obtained the Gold Medal at the Concours Mondial de Bruxelles 2021.
